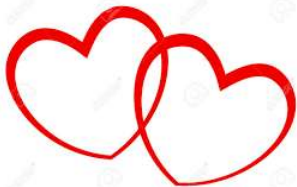
Order a beautiful bouquet of flowers for your beautiful sweetheart today
