We are in the process of putting together a memorial garden outside around the St. Theresa statue. Bricks with names of loved ones are being placed around the statue.

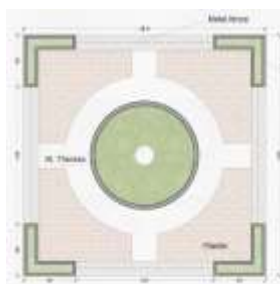
This is going to be a special place to remember those who have passed away or those who are still with us. These bricks will always be a part of our parish.
