

At our Catechists' Kickoff Day for children's religious education classes, Sr. Emily had a short 1 hour presentation on the Facts and Myths of Immigration Issues. Of our 800 children in religious ed. classes, 650 or so are Hispanic, many of whom are dealing with deportation and the demise of DACA. So we wanted our catechists to have some knowledge of what some of the children are experiencing in their lives.

Several people in the parishes have been asking if we can provide some instruction about these issues. Both the Priests of the Sacred Heart and the Sisters of Mercy (Sr. Emily's community) have websites for peace and justice. Both communities have people working full time with understanding these issues.
