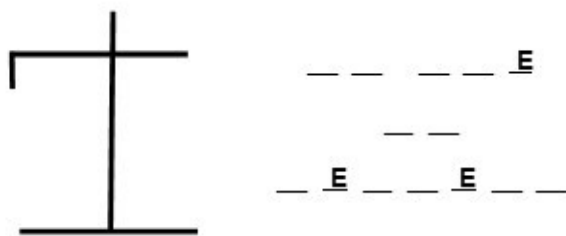

EDUCATION BUILDING NEW FIXTURES AND LED LIGHTING INSTALLED:

The replacement of 45 old fixtures with new fixtures and the LED lighting to go into these fixtures has been completed. Total cost was: 45 New fixtures \$2,611.50, Labor \$750.00.

This came to an expense total of \$3,361.50.

We received an Energy Rebate check for doing this from Entergy in the amount of \$2,392.00.

HOW DOES PARISH REGISTRATION HELP THE PARISH?

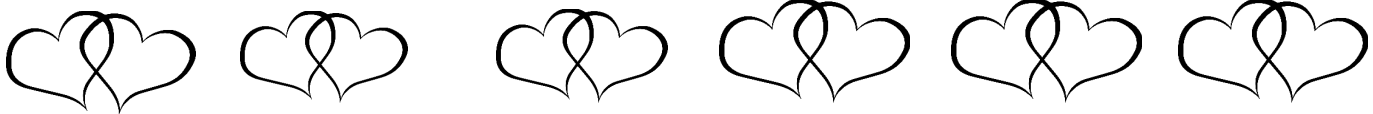
Many ways. First of all, who is part of this community; who helps to make it what it is; who can the parish staff count on to help with the many significant programs and events in the parish.

World Marriage Day 2018



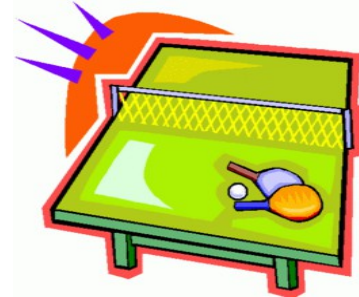
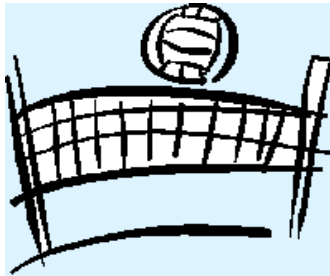
A 6 parish wide **World Marriage Day** celebration on Sunday, **February 11, 2018 at Holy Spirit from 4:00 pm until???**
