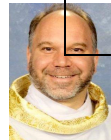

DON'T TAKE A VACATION FROM CHURCH

Please don't forget your parish while you are away on vacation. Remember that the day to day operations and expenses continue while you are gone.

Baptism registrations-- Please call Sister Emily for an appointment by July 26th. Registrations will take place on Saturday, August 4th. Baptism days are Saturday, August 25th and Sunday August 26th.



Qualifications for godparents are that they are practicing Catholics, registered in a parish, attending Mass regularly, baptized, confirmed, Holy Communion and if married, married in the Catholic Church. Godparents who live in another parish require a letter from their pastor recommending them as godparents.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING: --- The Diocese of Jackson uses VIRTUS Protecting God's Children, as the initial safe environment training to train clergy, religious, lay employees and volunteers about safe environments.



All adults working with our children and youth are required to go through this initial training and read a follow up article each month. There is a Parent session. There are also lessons for our children; these will be done during the PREP classes.

RCIA REGISTRATION IS OPEN. RCIA stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation. It is the process of preparing and celebrating the sacraments for those over the age of 7 who would like to be baptized, to come into the Catholic Church from another Christian denomination or for Catholic adults who have not yet completed their Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Communion and Confirmation.
