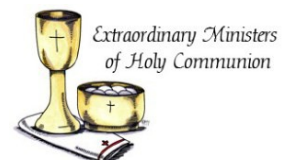

This is my story.

I was born in a beautiful Rocky Mountain village in New Mexico. The village's name is Aragon, named after my maternal grandfather, who came to the United States from Spain. We all spoke Spanish. My maternal grandmother was born in France. On my father's side, my grandfather was Scott-Irish, hence my name "Milligan." My paternal grandmother was Native American

My mother, I am told, was very kind, caring and gentle. She died when I was 3 years old, leaving my father and seven children – five boys and two girls. I am the second youngest. After my mother's death, my father needed to work in order to provide for all of us, so he was unable to keep us together. We were all separated, placed in a variety of settings in northern and western New Mexico. I am very grateful to my father for doing a great job of keeping us connected. He did this by taking one or the other to visit each other. This he could do perhaps one to two times a year.

As I was growing up I went to a number of schools. When I attended one school, I was taught by SISTERS. I witnessed their total dedication to God and to His people. And so, I decided that is what I would do. My motive was to give God a BIG THANK YOU that all of us 7 children, despite the many trials and tribulations growing up, had actually turned out "pretty good."

So today, **August 12th**, I am celebrating **60** years as a "SISTER." I am very grateful for all the opportunities God has given me to serve Him and His people – as a teacher, a missionary in Brazil, a psychologist and a social worker.

And ***THANK YOU ALL*** for celebrating with me,-----my life and my vocation.
