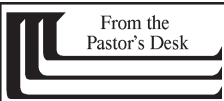
In an effort to update our prayer list we are asking that you contact the rectory with the names of those who should remain on the prayer list. If we have not heard from you by the end of July the name will be removed.

From the
Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

With the coming of summer, things in parishes slow down a bit especially in July and August. At the same time too, there are a few things which are still a work in process.

First – in the Archdiocese August 1 will see the implementation of Making All Things New. This has been a long process of acknowledging changing demographics in the Archdiocese and responding to those changes. Consequently, some parishes will be merged and Mass schedules changed. Additionally, some new parishes will be opened. In Orange County there are a few changes on the horizon. First, our neighbors at Assumption in Maybrook will be merged with St. Mary's in Montgomery; in many respects, this merge simply ratifies what has been the case anyway for about three years. St. Joseph's in New Windsor will be merged with St. Thomas in Cornwall; St. Thomas will be the anchor parish with the rectory office. St. Mary's in Newburgh will be merged with St. Patrick's and Sunday Mass will no longer be offered at St. Mary's; that is probably the biggest change we will see in this area. It is our hope that when all is said and done – the Church will be stronger and better prepared to respond to areas of growth.

More locally, a committee has been formed to prepare to celebrate the 100th anniversary of St. Benedict's, which will be celebrated in 2017.

Finally, come the fall we will begin RCIA classes. If you know anyone who would like to become Catholic, or if there are adult Catholics who need Holy Communion or Confirmation, please give some thought to coming closer to Christ in this Rite, through our Parish in the fall.
