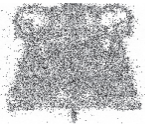

Every year, *World Mission Sunday* recalls our baptismal promise to be missionaries for the Lord. We gather at Mass, as do Catholics throughout the world, in a spirit of love for evangelization so that, through our prayers and acts of solidarity, the gift of our faith may be shared by all. This year's celebration is further enriched as we mark the 50th anniversary of the Second Vatican Councils *Decree on the Missionary Activity of the Church (Ad Gentes)* which proclaims, "The pilgrim Church on earth is missionary by its very nature," reminding us that all of us are called to be on mission.

In his message for *World Mission Sunday*, Pope Francis writes, "Mission is part of the 'grammar' of faith, something essential for those who listen to the voice of the spirit who whispers 'Come' and 'Go forth'. Those who follow Christ can not fail to be missionaries ..."

Your financial support on this *World Mission Sunday*, offered in the collection for the Society of the Propagation of the Faith, helps such efforts in 1,150 young mission dioceses throughout the world, reaching the poorest of communities with a message of hope, healing, mercy, and peace. Pope Francis emphasizes that "mission is a passion for Jesus and, at the same time, a passion for his people." Let us have that same passion this *World Mission Sunday* as we share the joy of the Gospel and help the poor with our fervent prayer and through our generous hearts!
