Dear Parishioners,

With the approach of Lent – I would like to remind you of an old tradition in our faith – daily Mass. It is not uncommon to see an increase in the number of people at daily Mass during Lent – which is a time to draw closer to Christ, especially in the celebration of the Eucharist. Going to daily Mass also gives people an opportunity to hear scripture every day – from the Old Testament and from the New Testament. At MPB we have two Masses Monday through Friday: 9:00 am and 12:10 pm. On Saturday, there is the 9:00, but not the 12:10. If you are home during the day and are able to come, I encourage you to make an effort.

In addition to daily Mass, going to Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a beautiful time for quiet prayer and reflection. At MPB we have exposition of the Blessed Sacrament every First Friday after the 9:00 Mass until 12:00, which is time for Benediction. This Friday coming up is First Friday, and again, there will time for quiet prayer, why not come in for a little visit?

Finally, at the last Parish Council meeting, study groups were discussed and it was suggested we see if there is interest, once a week for an hour and half, to come to together a few times during Lent to learn and discuss. 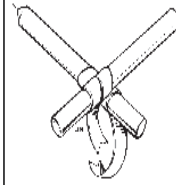
