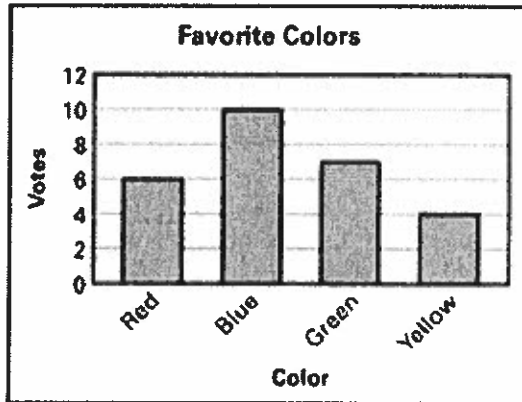

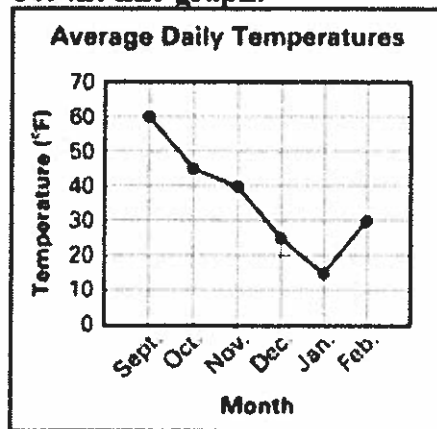

This summer, you will be reading the novel *Holes* by Louis Sachar. Alongside it, you will be completing a novel study on Google Docs.

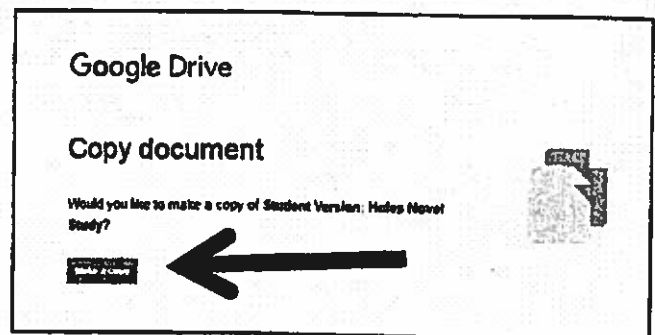
The novel is available at Barnes and Noble, the library, and Amazon for fairly cheap. Get started early—this is NOT something you'll want to put off!

Setting Up Your Novel Study

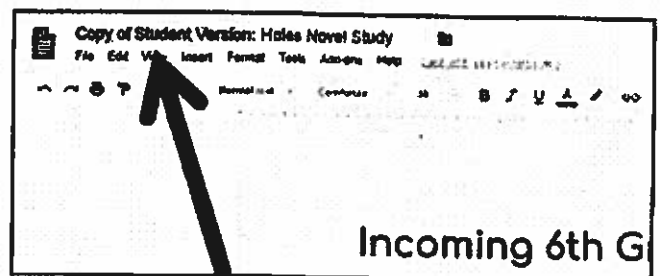
1. Go to <https://goo.gl/A9tSqZ> or scan this QR code with your phone. You will need to sign in to your school Gmail account.



2. You will arrive at this page. Click "Make a Copy."

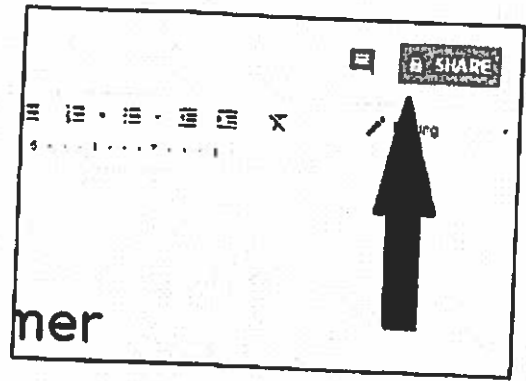


3. Next, you will arrive at this page. Rename it so the page is titled with "Your Name: Holes Novel Study"

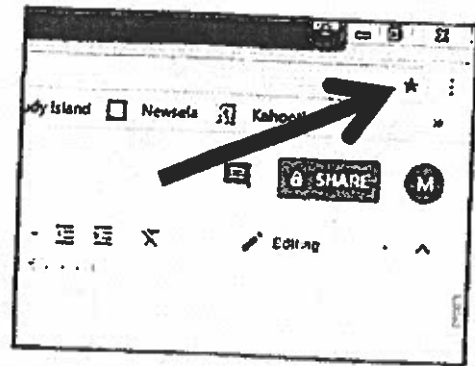

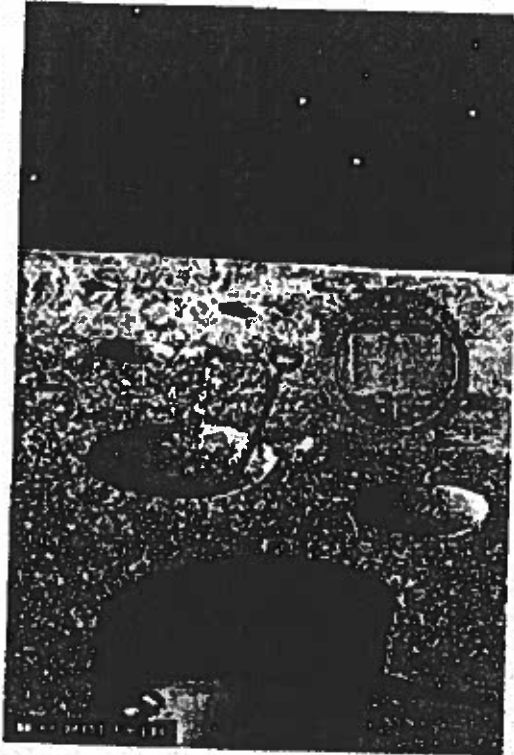
5. Pro tip: Save this page as a bookmark on your device so you can easily come back to it!
