Sanctuary Choir * is an ensemble who appreciate and share in the love of the deep Roman Catholic tradition of Sacred Music, and dedicate themselves to enriching the worship experience for the entire worshipping assembly. Members are adults of all ages. Our Sanctuary Choir will sing every Sunday at the 10:00am Liturgy. Rehearsals are on Tuesday evenings at 7:00 pm, and last about an hour and a half. In addition to preparing and presenting music every Sunday



at the 10:00am Liturgy from September through May, the choir presents an annual Advent-Christmas concert, and sings for all the Solemnities and most solemn Feast Days of the Liturgical Year. New members are always welcome!

Chapel Choir * is a select, auditioned, 'chamber' vocal group, ages 16 and over, who appreciate the challenge of performing the musically challenging accompanied and unaccompanied choral works of Gregorian Chant, Renaissance and polyphonic music of the Church. Rehearsals scheduled seasonally.

Youth Ensemble * is a vocal and instrumental ensemble for children



in grades 3 through 8. This program develops musical skills such as part-singing and vocal development and presents a varied repertoire of age appropriate sacred and liturgical music. The Youth Ensemble will sing at the 12:00noon liturgy on the third Sunday of each month from September through May. Rehearsals will be from 5:45-6:30 pm on Tuesdays, also from September through May. (This time and day may be subject to change.) The Ensemble will also prepare and sing for certain other occasions throughout the liturgical year. New members (singers and musicians) are always welcome!



SomersNights * is an ensemble for anyone in high school and older who enjoys learning, singing and playing a repertoire of contemporary liturgical music. The program will include music fundamentals, and welcomes both singers as well as musicians who want to share their love for God and His people through song. Instrumentalists are ALWAYS needed, particularly anyone who plays the keyboard, brass, string or woodwind instrument, guitar, drums, etc.

SomersNights will perform Sunday evenings at the 6:00pm liturgy, and will rehearse as scheduled on Wednesday evenings at 7:00 pm. New members are always welcome!
