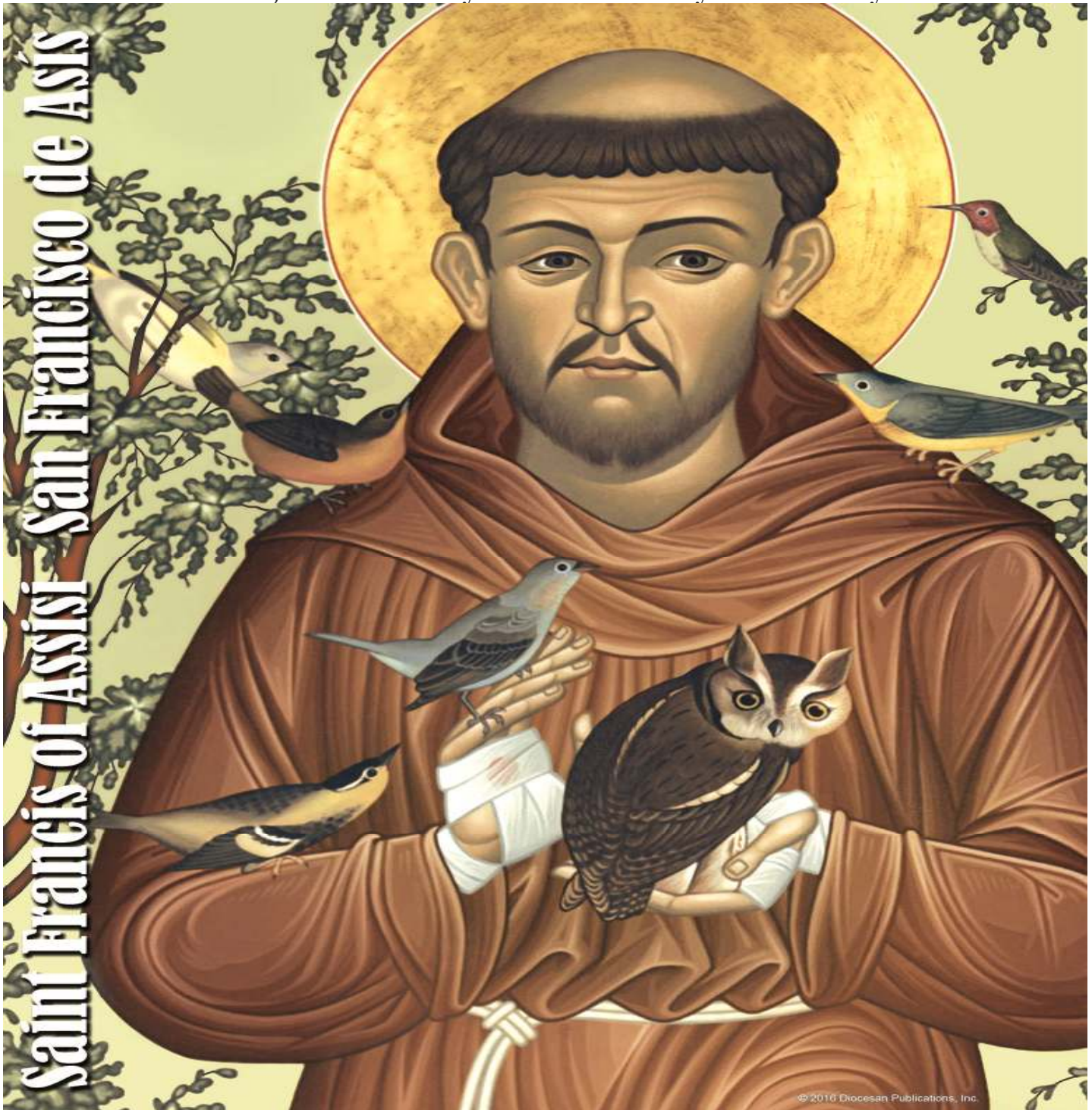


ST. MARY MYSTICAL ROSE GUIDING LIGHT

It's beginning to feel a lot like Fall is in the air. We continue to be amazed by the children of the parish, their eagerness to learn is astounding.

Some reminders:

Our faith formation opening Mass is this week, October 4th at 6:30. This Mass is a family Mass. We hope to see our faith formation families there. Feel free to invite Grandparents, Godparents, Aunts, Uncles and neighbors. Faith formation is primarily a work of the family, so we will ask God's blessing on all who help form our children in the faith as well as the children, and catechists.

On October 18th at 6:15 we will be having a parent formation session in the church while the children are doing their studies with the catechists. Our topic is "Passing on the Faith". All are welcome.

PARISH MEMBERSHIP: We joyfully welcome new members to our parish. Please register at the parish office during business hours. We also ask that you let us know if you plan to move from the parish.

INFANT BAPTISM: Parents must be registered and regularly attending the Sunday Eucharist to begin Baptism preparation. Baptismal Preparation is held quarterly. Call the parish office to for next scheduled date. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the first and third Sunday of every month.

MARRIAGE: If one of the engaged couple (or their parents) is registered at St. Mary's arrangements may be made personally by the couple at least six months in advance. 8-10 months is preferred.

SICK CALLS: We are happy to visit the sick and bring Communion to them. Please notify the parish office.

ANNULMENT PROCESS: If you are contemplating filing for an annulment; know that it is a healing process. It takes up to 18 months for the Tribunal to complete each case, so please take that into consideration. Call the parish office for more information.

October is National Pregnancy and Infant Loss Month. The Archdiocese of Detroit will support those desiring a baby while remembering those who have been lost at a Mass at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral next Sunday, October 9.
