4. Mass: Lord Have Mercy

Mercy and Repentance: in the Old Testament, the famous psalm describing God's Mercy is psalm 51 in which David is lamenting before God with all sincerity and humility for his sinful deeds: "Have mercy on me, O God...according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions..." Indeed this is a good psalm for anyone to recite and meditate about it when one really intends to ask for God's mercy with a humble and contrite heart. In the New Testament, the relationship mercy is better exemplified by the parable of the prodigal son. In this parable, the prodigal son begins to see the sinfulness of his actions, humbly repents, and returns home to his father. The father does not merely pardons his son for his offenses, but also he sees the good taking place in his son, his change of heart, his sorrow for his sins, and his noble desire to get his life back on track. The father rejoices in seeing this good in his son and eagerly welcomes him back. God sees not just the legal fact of our sins. He also sees our contrite heart. As the psalm 51 says, "God will not spurn a humble and contrite heart (Ps 51:17)." This is the typical nature of God and the proper context for understanding God's mercy. Mercy is not to be seen as a higher power like a king randomly pardoning his criminals; it is about God's love for us even in the face of our sins. One would therefore realize that God can differentiate the sinner from his or her sins. That's why he forgives sins and loves the sinner precisely because he sees the good, the new direction taking place in his or her genuine contrition of heart.

Mercy and assistance in life: While "Lord have mercy" primarily an expression of repentance, it also can be seen as a petition, prayer representing the cry of God's people for assistance in their lives. In this regard, many people approach Jesus asking for his mercy in the sense of pleading for healing and help in their lives. For instance, two blind men come to Jesus, saying, "Have mercy on us, Son of David" (Mt 9:27); the blind beggar does the same (Mk 10:46); similarly ten lepers call out to Christ, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us" (Lk 17:13). We do believe that we find comfort and strength when we cry out "Lord, have mercy." Similarly, we can also entrust to the Lord our own suffering, physical ailments, personal trials, even our own spiritual blindness, weakness, and sin in the prayer "Lord, have mercy."

Mercy for others: The gospels also tell people coming to Jesus requesting mercy not just for themselves, but also for others whom they love. For instance, a mother cries out to Jesus to help her daughter, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, my daughter is severely possessed by a demon" (Mt 15:22). A father desperately turns to Jesus on behalf of his son's troubles, saying, "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic, and suffers terribly" (Mt 17: 15). Likewise, we too can entrust to the Lord those we love every time pray the Kyrie at Mass.
