## A Year of Mercy with Pope Francis

### May 01

**The Sweetness of Our Lady:** We are in need today of the sweetness of Our Lady to understand the things that Jesus asks of us. It is not an easy list to put into practice: love your enemies, do good, give without hoping for anything in return, to him who strikes you offer the other cheek, to him who takes your cloak offer your tunic as well. These are heavy demands. But all of them were lived by Our Lady in her own way.

-Homily, *Domus Sanctae Marthae*, Feast of the Holy Name of Mary, September 12, 2013

**Reflection:** Mary lived in poverty under the oppressive government of the Roman Empire. She constantly had opportunities to put love into practice, both in the grind of her daily life as a woman of poverty and when enduring the demands of the government. Ask Mary to teach you the way of Jesus. Ask her to help you learn to think and act with mercy.

### May 02

**Spiritual Worldliness Camouflaged:** Any Church community, if it thinks it can comfortably go its own way without creative concern and effective cooperation in helping the poor to live with dignity and reaching out to everyone, will also risk breaking down, however much it may talk about social issues or criticize governments. It will easily drift into a spiritual worldliness camouflaged by religious practices, unproductive meeting and empty talk.

**Reflection:** Is your parish comfortable? Does it risk breaking down? What's one step you can make to creatively and effectively help the poor within your own parish boundaries?

### May 03

**Mary's Magnificat:** The model of this spiritual disposition, of moving forward in hope, of this way of being and journeying in life, is the Virgin Mary. A simple girl from the country who carries within her heart the fullness of hope in God! In her womb, God's hope took flesh, it became man, it became history, Jesus Christ.

Her Magnificat is the canticle of the People of God on a journey, and of all men and women who hope in God and in the power of his mercy. Let us allow ourselves to be guided by her, she who is mother, a mamma, and know how to guide us.

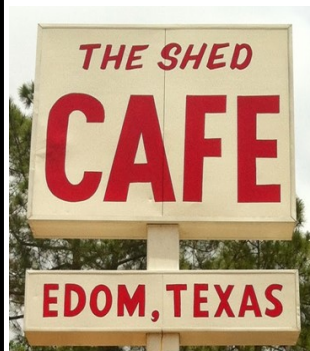

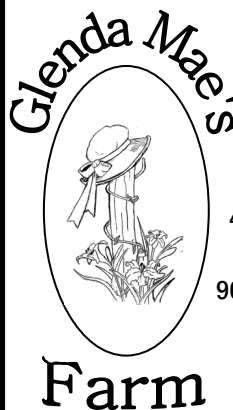
