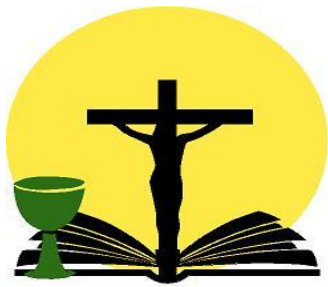

Easter is the celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead. It is celebrated on Sunday, and marks the end of Holy Week, the end of Lent, the last day of the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday), and is the beginning of the Easter season of the liturgical year.

As we know from the Gospels, Jesus Christ rose from the dead on the third day following his crucifixion, which would be Sunday. His resurrection marks the triumph of good over evil, sin and death. It is the singular event which proves that those who trust in God and accept Christ will be raised from the dead.

Since Easter represents the fulfillment of God's promises to mankind, it is the most important holiday on the Christian calendar.

Pray For Me

Jesus prays for us! Jesus who prays, Jesus the man-God who prays! And he prays for us: he prays for me, he prays for you, and for each one of us...

When --- (whether) at church, at home with our families – we are in need or have problems, we say “pray for me,” we have to say the same to Jesus: “Lord, pray for me”... We must have this faith that Jesus, in this moment intercedes before the Father for us, for each one of us. And when we pray, we are asking: Jesus, give me strength, solve this problem, forgive me!”

Reflection: Where do you turn to when you have problems? Do you first try to solve them yourself? Do you turn to others to solve them for you? Turn to God first. Let him be the first to hear your needs.

6. Building Improvement. The two HVAC units in the church have been replaced at a cost of \$5500. Remember this when the Building Maintenance envelope comes up for second mile giving. Our fund is down to \$4554. We are also buying another more efficient copy machine. It will pay for itself in about 5 years. Note, users will have to have a key code to use the machine. Every group will have a code. Cost of machine installation about \$2200. Balance in building maintenance fund down to \$2350.
