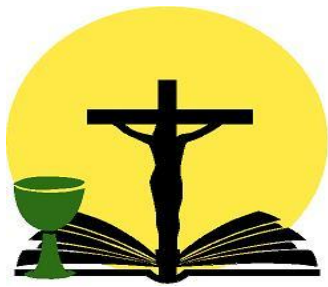

**Youth News – Invite Your Fiends To Join Us On Our Lenten Journey**

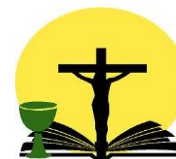
The Youth class for Jr High and High School are about to start classes with Father Paul Wednesday Evenings during CCD Class. We will be discussing Dating and understanding our sexuality using the book, “How to find your soulmate without losing your soul.” **Please encourage your student to join us these next two weeks. Parents are also encouraged to come.**

How important is it to become capable of teaching? St. Paul along with our Bishop felt it is very important. Hebrews 5: 11-14 About this we have much to say, and it is difficult to explain, for you have become sluggish in hearing, Although you should be teachers by this time, you need to have someone teach you again the basic elements of the utterances of God. You need milk, not solid food. Everyone who lives on milk lacks experience of the word of righteousness, for he is a child. But solid food is for the mature, for those whose faculties are trained by practice to discern good and evil.

We need to decide on the final location and style of the Grotto at this time. Fr. Paul wants to have the Grotto built by some time this summer.
4. Our Adult Faith Formation Class is doing the Great Adventure 24-week Bible Study. Everyone is invited to join us, even if you did not sign up for the class. This is an adventure through the Bible and all are welcome. Next class will be on the Exile, lesson 15.
5. "The Priests for Tomorrow, Teacher of Truth" Diocesan Capital Fund Drive is coming to its conclusion. I would like to see at least half of our 170 families pledge something, thus being participants in this very important stage of growth of our parish. If we can reach \$305,000 pledged, we will have \$172,000 pledged to the Parish and \$130,000 pledged to the Bishop's campaign.

You have three important opportunities to pledge.

2. In Mass Saturday and Sunday, May 12 & 13, an opportunity will be given in Mass for individuals and families to make pledges.

Father Paul warmly invites you to participate in this campaign. It will be laying the foundation for our future growth and ministry to both children and adults.

6. We will be obtaining the Catholic education on-line resources from "FORMED", from the Augustine Institute in the near future. Keep your eyes open for great resources. We will soon have the materials stand from Lighthouse Catholic Ministries, containing many resources for reading.
