**How important is it to become capable of teaching? St Paul along with our Bishop feel it is very important! See Hebrews 5:11-14:**

“About this we have much to say, and it is difficult to explain, for you have become sluggish in hearing, Although you should be **teachers** by this time, you need to have someone teach you again the basic elements of the utterances of God. You need milk, not solid food. Everyone who lives on milk lacks experience of the word of righteousness, for he is a child. But solid food is for the mature, for those whose faculties are trained by practice to discern good and evil.”

**Stewardship**

Mary shows us the meaning of following the will of God. She gave her life completely to God with absolute trust and a faith-filled open heart. As stewards, we pray for her guidance as we strive to become faithful disciples of her Son, Jesus. “Ascribe to the lord the glory due to his name; bring an offering and come into his courts.” -Psalm 96:8



## Our Real Journey

Even if we are sometimes unfaithful to him, he remains faithful. In his mercy, he never tires of stretching out his hand to lift us up, to encourage us to continue our journey, to come back and tell him of our weakness, so that he can grant us his strength. This is the real journey: to walk with the Lord always, even at moments of weakness, even in our sins. Never to prefer a makeshift path of our own. That kills us.

**Reflection:** What journey is the Lord leading you on? Where have you left the path? In his mercy, Jesus stretches his hand toward you. Ask God for the courage and strength to reach out to him.
