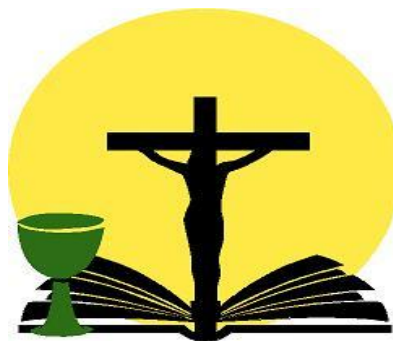

What Weighs You Down

In the Gospel passage [of the Samaritan Woman] we likewise find the impetus to “leave behind our water jar”, the symbol of everything that is seemingly important, but loses all its value before the “love of God”. We all have one, or more than one! I ask you, and myself: “what is your interior water jar, the one that weighs you down, that distances you from God? Let us set aside a little and with our hearts; let us hear the voice of Jesus offering us another kind of water, another water that brings us to close to the Lord.

Reflection: We are filled with so many things. Take time to be filled with the mercy of God. He will bring you freedom from anxiety, from resentment, from selflessness. What weighs you down? What distances you from God? Allow the mercy of God to be the number one priority in your life.

Te pregunto a ti y a mí mismo: “¿Cuál es tu tarro de agua interior, el que te pesa, que te aleja de Dios? Dejemos a un lado un poco y con nuestros corazones; Escuchemos la voz de Jesús ofreciéndonos otro tipo de agua, otra agua que nos acerque al Señor.

Reflexión: Estamos llenos de tantas cosas. Tómese el tiempo para llenarse de la misericordia de Dios. Él te traerá la libertad de la ansiedad, del resentimiento, de la abnegación. ¿Qué te pesa? ¿Qué te aleja de Dios? Permita que la misericordia de Dios sea la prioridad número uno en su vida.
