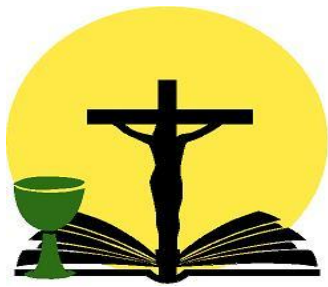

Sunday Scripture Highlight

There is a great division between the righteous & the evil.

Read Psalm 1

Jeremiah says: Cursed is the one... whose heart turns away from the Lord... he stands in a lava waste, a salt & empty earth. Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord. He is like a tree planted beside the water... that fears not the heat when it comes; it stays green; it still bears fruit.

Stewardship

Stewardship is intimately connected with a parish’s communication, education, & evangelizing efforts. It has to do with how well we know each other & how well we care for one another. Read Acts 2:42-47 & Acts 4:32-35. They taught together; they celebrated the Eucharist & ate together; and they prayed together.



In the Household

Relationships based on faithful love, until death, like marriage, fatherhood, being child or sibling, are learned and lived in the household. When these relationships form the basic fabric of a human society, they lend cohesion and consistency.

It is therefore not possible to be part of a people, to feel as a neighbor, to take care of someone who is more distant and unfortunate if, in the heart of man, these fundamental relationships, which give him security in openness toward others, are broken.

Reflection: Our family relationships help us learn the virtue of mercy as we develop the habits of loving, forgiving, and serving, and serving one another. Where is God calling you to grow in mercy within your family? Where is it difficult to love right now? Ask God for the strength to increase your love.
