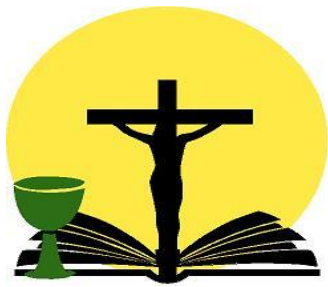

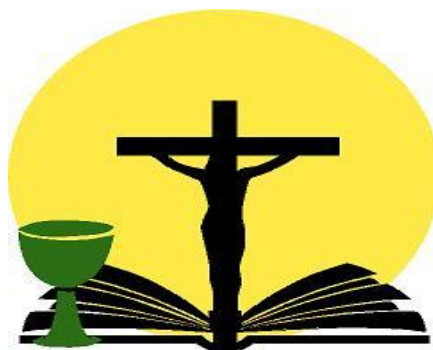
God of Hope, We encounter you in refugees.

Journey to Uganda

Annet’s youngest sister calls her mom, and for good reason. Since their parent’s death 4 years ago, 16-year-old Annet has been caring for her three youngest siblings. It hasn’t been easy. Ongoing violence in their home country, South Sudan, forced Annet to take her brother and sisters and flee to Uganda. Now they live in Bidi Bidi, one of the world’s largest refugee settlements. While Annet is happy to be away from the violence, life in Bidi Bidi is hard, especially for a young woman trying to raise her siblings, that’s why CRS is building houses for families like Annet’s. A place to call to call home means Annet can rest a little easier at night knowing her family is safe. While she wants to return to South Sudan, for now she knows that Bidi Bidi is the safer option. “My hope is to raise my siblings,” she says.”And I know I can do it with the help of CRS and my Catholic faith.”

Stewardship
