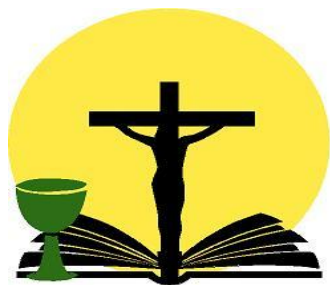

Sunday Scripture and Stewardship Highlight

Today’s readings on this fourth Sunday of Easter offer us a glimpse into the heart of our loving Savior. He is the Good Shepherd and we can confidently place our trust in Him as we live the stewardship way of life. He is, therefore, the best model for leadership in our world today and his Word gives precious guidance for good leadership now. In both the first and second readings, we find Peter embracing his role as leader of the newborn Church. In our first reading from Acts, he exhorts the crowd, “Save yourselves from this corrupt generation.” We then read that the ones who accepted his message were baptized that day. We, too, are challenged to “save ourselves from this corrupt generation.” To follow Jesus requires a renunciation of all sources of evil and the embracing of the call to discipleship through the stewardship way of life, using our time, talents and treasure for others, not just ourselves, in this confusing time. If we do so, we will find a path to freedom from “this corrupt generation” just as those first disciples found in the early days of the Church. Our second reading, again featuring St. Peter, offers further motivation for embracing this way of life. Peter reminds us that Christ, “bore our sins in his body upon the cross.” And that, “by his wounds you have been healed. For [we] had gone astray like sheep but... have now returned to the shepherd and guardian of [our] souls.” Such an incredibly poignant description of the love our Savior has for us and the kind of relationship He desires to have with us — as shepherd and guardian of our souls. This aspect of our Lord’s tender and personal love for each one of us is yet another reason to embrace the stewardship way of life — in the offering of our time, talent and treasure to Him, we can express our gratitude to Him for the incomprehensible love He has for us. He offers Himself as the guardian of our souls. He has withheld nothing of Himself and His goodness from us. He would never ask anything of us that would bring us harm. This Easter season let us resolve to freely give all of ourselves and our lives gratefully to Him.
