**Stewardship Reflection**

In our Gospel passage, from Matthew, Jesus poses a question to the disciples: “Who do people say that the Son of Man is?” And they offer varying responses. Then, Jesus gets personal with them. “But who do you say that I am?” Peter gets the answer right: “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” Then Jesus says, “You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church...” So, Peter is the first Pope (Father) of the church and therefore the chief steward. Jesus, then, poses the same question to each of us who call ourselves His stewards and modern-day disciples. But do our lives truly reflect this? If we really believe that Christ is the Son of God, sent to save us from our sins and lead us to Heaven, then we must say so, not just with words but with our actions. What a great calling to “manage” not only my time, talents, and treasure,” but also all the material and spiritual possessions my God has given me! How can I do this better to the glory of God?

- In Tyler: Drs. Lloyd and Roberts at the Exceptional Emergency Center, 2222 ESE Loop 323, Tyler, TX. This is close to the Troop Hwy/Loop 323 intersection. Note that this is an Emergency Center whose treatment rates are higher than clinics. The initial visit may be free. Personal insurance usually covers costs. Medicare and Medicaid are not accepted. Cash price for full visit, \$200.
  - Dr. Paul Guttuso, Family Medicine at Texas Health family and Sports Care, 604 South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Suite A, Mabank, TX 75147. Call for appointment (903-887-1073) Cash cost for visit is \$110 plus \$30 medicine. Identify yourself as referred by Father Paul Key.
  - Dr. Ivette Lozano, family doctor, Walk-in Clinic, 10425 Garland Rd., Dallas TX 75218. She is taking new patients only on Mondays and Wednesdays. Look up on Google, Lozano Clinic, but be careful, there are three "Lozano" clinics in Dallas.
- No one at U. T. Northeast (old ETMC) nor Christus Trinity Mother Frances will do it.

**2. A doctor recommended** set of supplements: 3,000 I.U. of vitamin D-3, both morning and evening; 50 mg of Zinc, morning and evening, and 1,000 mg vitamin C per day. This should give more resistance.
