

I hope that this txt finds everyone doing well I wanted to share a couple things with everyone from Fr Paul.

1. The church will be open daily from 8:00am - 7:00 pm for prayer. Bishop Strickland has asked that we limit 5 persons at a time inside the church and has requested that u allow for 10-15 min at a time so that anyone wishing to have prayer time may do so. If u are there by yourself it is fine to spend the quiet time with the Lord but if u see others waiting to pray pls be mindful of the time limit. He has also asked that u pray at the designated marked locations in the church and pls use the Lysol wipes to sanitize the area you are praying in before and after prayer time. Those can be found on the table at the back of the church. There is no hand sanitizer at the church for public use if you have your personal bottle please use that to keep germs from spreading.

2. Fr Paul will be available for confession on Tuesdays and Fridays from 5:30-7:00 pm you may also call txt or email Fr Paul for a personal confession time. Confessions will be heard in the office to allow for the space between the person confessing and Fr Paul pls be respectful of this if u see someone at the church pls check the surrounding areas of the church before entering the office to be mindful of others who may be giving confession.

3. If you would like for Fr Paul to say a special Mass intention, you may call Fr Paul with those or drop those by the office.

4. Tithes- if you would like to drop your tithes off at the church office you may do so or sign up for our online giving on the church website at [stbonifacehandler.org](http://stbonifacehandler.org)

5. There will be no public masses at this time, Fr Paul will be saying private Masses daily and the weekend Mass will be live streamed on our Facebook page. You may also watch the Livestream of Bishop Strickland who also will be streaming the Mass as well as EWTN. I do hope everyone is doing well and am praying for each of you. If anyone in our community needs anything pls do not hesitate to ask we do have volunteers in place to help with any need that you may have.

6. Adoration will continue on Thursday nights, from 5 to 8pm. Again, be mindful of the rule of 5, if more than that will be attending, then please wait for others to leave.

Wipe down the area that you occupy, before and after you pray. Lysol wipes will be in the Community room.
