Holy Week Program

As we continue to experience inconveniences and disruptions in our daily lives due to the COVID-19 virus outbreak, it becomes necessary to adjust and adopt our Holy week celebrations this year. Keeping in mind the direction of the Diocese of Crookston and Governor's Order, St. Theodore's and Our Lady of the Pines Catholic Churches will have the following program during Holy week:

Palm / Passion Sunday - April 5th: NO public Masses will be celebrated. Blessing of the Palm will be held privately without the Congregation. Blessed Palms will be made available to the parishioners at the main entrance of St. Theodore's Church, Laporte and Our Lady of the Pines Church, Nevis from 5:00 PM Saturday, April 4th to 12 Noon, Sunday April 5th. You are most welcome to pick up a blessed palm during this time, keeping the rules for "Social Distancing".

Chrism Mass Postponed - April 6th: Because large gatherings are not allowed at this time, the Bishop of Crookston has postponed the celebration of the Chrism Mass this year to a date yet to be determined. We will continue to use the oils in our parishes that were blessed last year.

Holy Thursday - April 9th: There won't be any services in our parishes. Bishop Michael Hoeppner will be celebrating a private 'Mass of the Lord's Supper' at 7:00 PM in the Cathedral of Immaculate Conception, Crookston, which will be live streamed at: www.facebook.com/diocrookston. We ask you to join in this service by clicking the above link.

Good Friday - April 10th: There will not be any services in our parishes. Bishop Michael Hoeppner will hold the 'Commemoration of the Passion of Our Lord' in a private celebration at 3:00 PM in the Cathedral of Immaculate Conception, Crookston. Holy Saturday Easter Vigil - April 11th: We will not have the Easter Vigil celebrated in our parishes. Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting System

The new Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting (CBAR) service became operational **Monday, March 16**. The Bishops of the United States approved the national reporting system following Pope Francis' May 2019 apostolic letter, *Vos estis lux mundi* ("You are the light of the world"), to address the issue of sexual abuse and bishop accountability in the global Catholic Church.

CBAR is one way to report allegations, operated by Convercent, Inc., an independent, third party entity that provides intake services to private institutions for reports of sensitive topics such as sexual harassment, through a secure, confidential, and professional platform. Individuals may make a report by accessing ReportBishopAbuse.org or calling (800) 276-1562. Reports are taken 24 hours a day in English and Spanish.
