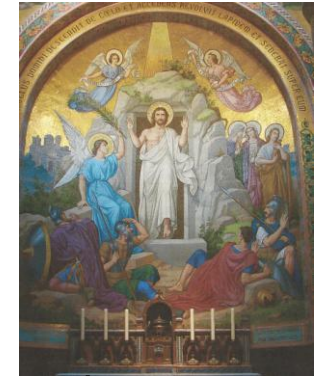

### **Cemetery Guidelines**

1. Families are encouraged to visit the grave sites of loved ones to pray for the dead, remember the cherished moments, and celebrate our Faith in Christ and His promise for our Resurrection on the Last Day.
2. Monuments and grave markers are the property and responsibility of the family for maintenance or repair. You are welcome to enhance them with small vases of flowers or tasteful remembrances between Memorial and Labor Days. Please place no plantings. Items that interfere with mowing or are unsightly will be removed.
3. The parish provides perpetual care of the cemetery grounds with appropriate mowing, trimming, and weed control. Donations to the Perpetuity Fund are always welcome.
4. Respectful, reverent behavior is the norm in the cemetery.

6. If this certificate is to be transferred to the designated heir, please return this certificate to the parish office (205 Main St, Nevis, MN 56467) with updated address information.

### **Burial Guidelines**

1. All burials must be coordinated through the parish office in Nevis 218-652-4005.
2. This is a Catholic cemetery. Burials must be in accord with the Rite of Christian Burial and be performed by a priest or Christian minister.
3. Each burial plot is intended for the casket of one individual or the cremains of two individuals.
2. Burial vaults or grave liners are required (including wooden urns for cremains). Vaults/liners are available through funeral homes.
3. Families are asked to provide the parish office with a copy of the deceased's obituary as soon as possible.
4. Local Funeral Homes can be contacted through information in the phone directories of: Walker, Bemidji, or Park Rapids, MN
